

### Term: Autumn Term

#### Reading

The students will be following the 'Sounds' Write' phonics scheme which will consolidate prior learning of letter

sounds, spelling and handwriting. Students will also be learning to:

- take turns when speaking •
- extend their knowledge of tricky words •
- blend sounds together to make words ٠
- read and write the letters, and order, of the ٠ alphabet
- spell common exception words •
- form lower case letters correctly

Students will be focussing on using their phonics in Reading lessons to sound out words and being to read fluently. There will be continual discussions about the text and students will learn how to retrieve information from the text to answer questions. Before reading a text, students will make basic predictions about what they think will happen in the text. Students will also use different strategies to clarify the meaning of difficult words.

Children will be bringing home their reading book. Please make the time to read with your child for 10 minutes every night and encourage them to discuss the

### Writing

In Literacy, we will be using Talk4Writing techniques to focus on building confidence in telling a story or reciting a poem before writing it down.

Children will use their imaginations to create character descriptions and write stories based on familiar settings. While writing, we will be focussing on using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces to ensure we are writing correctly punctuated sentences.

As well as Literacy we will have regular handwriting practice to ensure our letters are formed correctly and of a consistent size so we can make sure we are all taking pride in the presentation of our book work.
