






How to Upload Picture of Home-Learning onto Purple Mash

<p>Step 1: Ensure the photo you want to upload is saved on the device you are logging into Purple Mash on.</p>	
<p>Step 2: Login to Purple Mash as normal.</p>	
<p>Step 3: Click on the 'Work' icon on the top bar.</p>	
<p>Step 4: In the 'My Work' tool bar, click on 'Upload'.</p>	
<p>Step 5: Click on the arrow in the 'Upload Documents' window.</p>	
<p>Step 6: A window will pop up for you to browse your files. Locate the folder where you've saved the picture. Click on the correct file and press 'Open'.</p>	
<p>Step 7: The picture will upload (shown in the green bar), and then you press 'Done'.</p>	
<p>Step 8: The picture will then be uploaded into the 'work' file of your child. In order for the teachers to know that it is there, your child will then need to leave a comment telling them on their class blog.</p>
